- In its effort to improve efficient record keeping at Laboratories of the participating Hospitals, the Jini Na project developed a customized record keeping booklet for use at the health facilities.

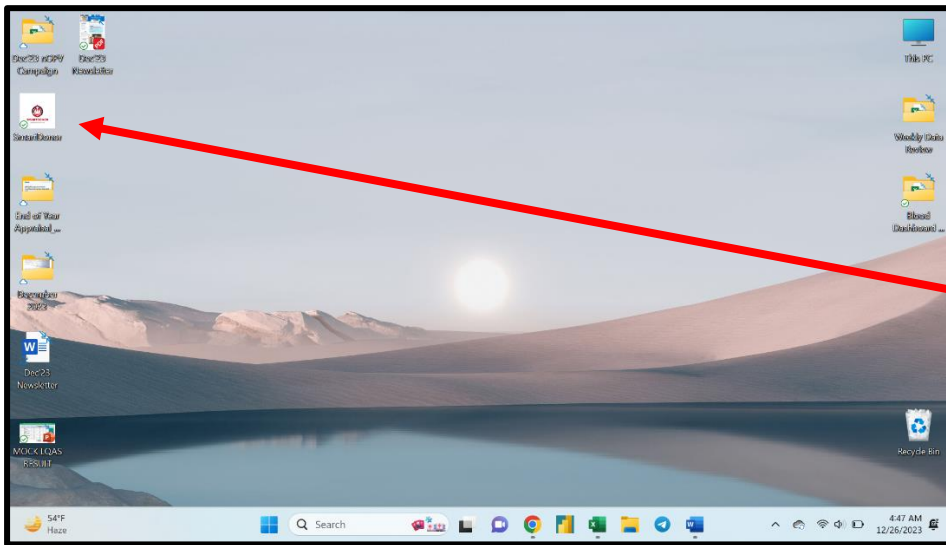

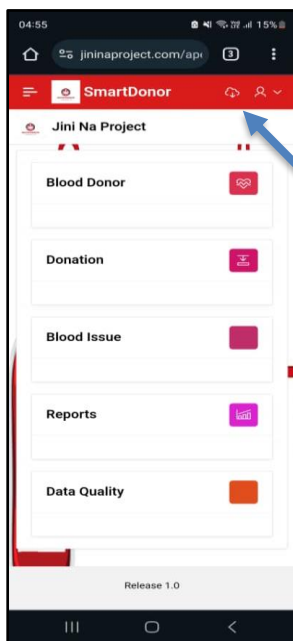
Update on Smart Donor App



- The Application Software that the Jini Na project is using in data collection is dynamic and work in progress as the study goes on the need for modifications to the App kept arising.
- The Smart Donor App is initially a web based data collection tool (that means you have to pass through your web browser such as chrome, internet explorer, Safari, etc for you to work upon) but with the new update now you can Install the App as a stand alone independent from a browser on both Desktop (e.g on Laptops) and on Mobile devices (Tablets and Phones).

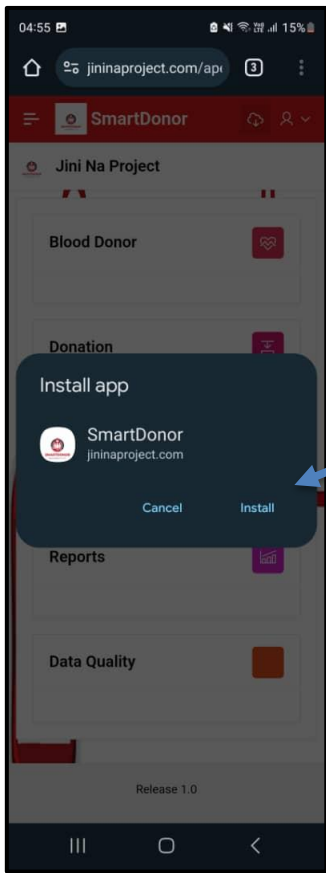


A Smart Donor App Icon on a Laptop Screen.



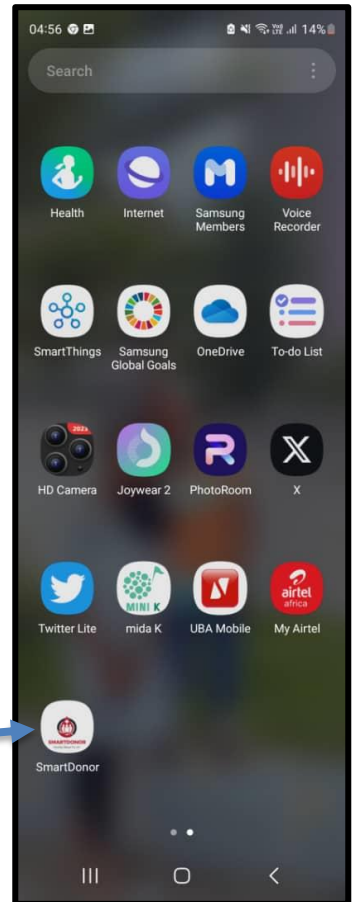
STEP 1

After Login in with your details, you will see a download sign at the extreme Right-hand corner of the software close to your Sign-in/Sign-out icon



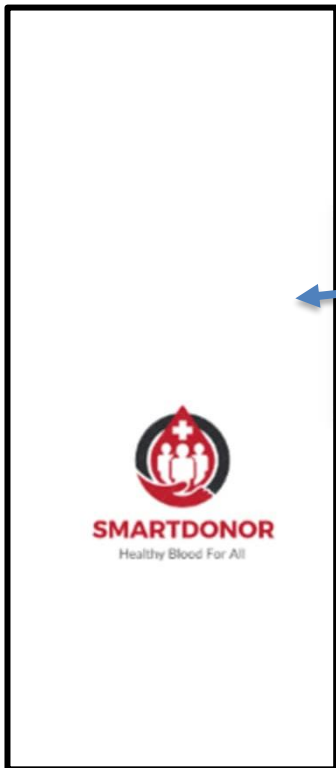
STEP 2

The "Install App" Dialogue Box will appear on top your screen. Click on the "Install"



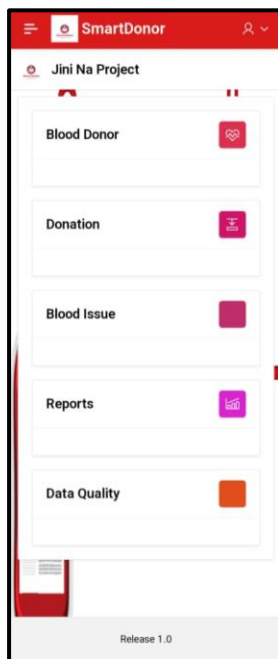
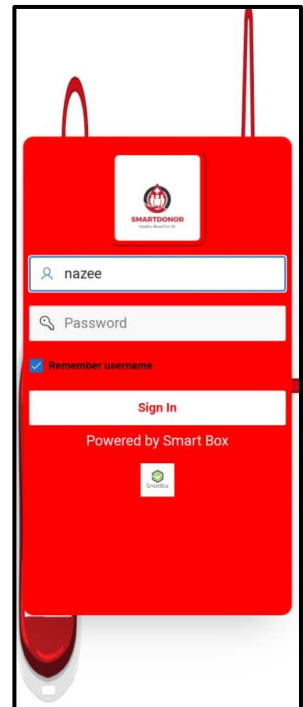
STEP 3
